LtCol (OF4) Prof Alexandre Papy (ir PhD) has a master in engineering (specialization in weapon systems and ballistics.) and a PhD in mechanical engineering (internal ballistics).

After a military training as a GBAD/IF officer he has been working in an artillery operational unit where he led the Fire Direction Center. He then became an Assistant, Associate Professor and then Professor in the department of weapons systems and ballistics of the Royal Military Academy in Brussels, Belgium.

At NATO level, he did start working in the field of non-lethal capabilities where he used to be chairman of the Joint Non-Lethal Weapons Capability Group and is still chairing the standardization and CUAV subgroups.
At EU level is is chairing the European Working Group on Non-Lethal Weapons.

Around 2015, he broadened his scope by being active in the field of counter-UAS.
He is part of different NATO and EU Counter UAS initiatives and has chaired the NATO DAT C-UAV project.
